

Heritage Open Days Visitor Survey

Terms & Conditions for the Prize Draw

Draw Date:

- 1st October 2025
- Winners will be drawn at random on the Prize Draw Date.

Entry:

- The prize draw is open to all residents of the UK over the age of 18, except for employees of the National Trust, Heritage Open Days, their families or anyone else associated with this competition.
- Entry to the prize draw is made on successful completion of the survey.
 Respondents can choose to opt out of the prize draw on completion of the survey if they do not agree with the terms and conditions. In the event that a participant does not qualify to take part in the survey they cannot enter the prize draw.
- Surveys completed after the final closing date of 28th September 2025 will not be entered into the prize draw.

Prize:

- The prize is 1x £250 voucher towards any National Trust Holiday to be booked and taken by 31th December 2026. Destinations can be found on the <u>National Trust Holidays website</u>. Please note this excludes Historic House Hotels and accommodation managed by third party providers. The competition winner can use the prize as part payment towards a higher value holiday and pay the balance.
- If the holiday booked is less than £250 in value this booking will still be deemed full settlement of the prize and any remaining value cannot be used towards a second break.
- Heritage Open Days/The National Trust will not be responsible for any other transport or accommodation costs incurred in the acceptance or fulfilment of the prize.
- Travel to the holiday destination is not included and you will need to make your own travel arrangements. National Trust Holidays are self-catering. The prize does not include food or other extras.
