

Competition Terms and Conditions

Heritage Open Days Competition

1. These competition are open to all residents of the UK, except for employees of the National Trust, Heritage Open Days, their families or anyone else associated with this competition.
2. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all terms and conditions are adhered to. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
4. Entries can only be accepted via completion of the entry form after having taken the Heritage Open Days 2019 visitor survey.
5. All entries must be received by the competition closing date as stated. Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
6. Entrants under the age of 16 must obtain the consent of a parent or guardian prior to submitting any entries
7. The winning entry will be chosen at random from all entries.
8. Winners will be notified by directly by email.
If a winner cannot be contacted or is not available, the judges reserve the right to select another winner from the eligible entries which were received before the closing date.
9. The overall winner of the competition will win the prize stipulated on the survey. The prizes as described are available on the date of publication.
All prizes are non-transferable and there are no cash alternatives.
10. Events may occur that render the competition itself or the awarding of the prize[s] impossible due to reasons beyond the control of Heritage Open Days and accordingly Heritage Open Days may at its absolute discretion vary or amend the promotion and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the promoter as a result thereof.
